2. RULES AND REGULATIONS:

- a. As Beulah members, our primary assignment is to clean the auditorium and prepare it for any special program.
- b. Beulah members represent the Church management; therefore, no member should disobey camp rules or engage in any form of misconduct. Any member found guilty of misconduct will face penalties.
- c. Members who inadvertently leave the group have a 12-hour window to reach out to the Coordinator or any Executive member; otherwise, it will be deemed a voluntary exit.
- d. Any member leaving the WhatsApp group in annoyance will not be re-added unless they reinitiate the membership process. This entails going through the steps of becoming an intending member before verification.

3. INTENDING MEMBERS:

- a. Intending members are subject to a probationary period and will be added to the main group within 3-6 months, based on their evaluation. Any unclear matters for intending members should be addressed with the appropriate office.

b. Intending members will wear a red armless uniform labeled with "(IN)" on the back. This uniform is non-purchasable and should be returned to the Admission Team after the program.

c. Intending members are not authorized to purchase uniforms until they are fully verified and added to the verified group.

d. An intending member who misses two special programs will not be added to the verified group.

e. Intending members are required to pay three months of monthly dues upfront immediately after completing their internship. After that, they will be added to the main platform.

F. Beulah has a massive duty in the camp, and even with all our members present, we are not enough for the task. For this reason, once you are a Beulah member, you cannot be part of another group. If you insist on joining another group and we discover this with meaningful evidence, you will be blacklisted or disengaged from Beulah

4. COMMITTEE: COMMITTEE SELECTED BY THE EXECUTIVE OR GENERAL MEMBER

a. All committees formed by the Executives or general members should first report to the Coordinator before seeking a meeting with the Executives. If the Coordinator is unreachable, any Executive member can be contacted.

b. Job descriptions for all committees must be announced prior to nominating committee members.

c. The duration of the committee's term should be agreed upon before nominations.

d. If a committee fails to deliver within the agreed-upon timeframe, the Executive can take over the task or reassign it to another group.

e. Executives possessing verified information that could implicate members

of a specific committee may take over the process or replace implicated individuals.

5. DURING 72HRS, CROSS-OVER, AND ANY SPECIAL PROGRAMS

a. All members must register upon arrival at the Beulah Room or Auditorium.

b. Participants in the 72hrs program should engage in final cleaning on Thursday evening after the Prophetic Declaration.

c. Duty rosters will be posted on the Beulah WhatsApp platform at least two hours before prayer sessions.

d. Members are expected to follow the instructions of their team lead regarding position placement. Failure to comply will result in removal from the roster for that program. Irregularities in roster placement should be reported to the Coordinator.

e. For any special program, Beulah will officiate. The Coordinator will announce the uniform attire a few days prior to the event.

f. On Thursday evening, following the final setup, a brief meeting will be held to prepare for the next day's officiating.

g. Members arriving at the camp on Friday or Saturday should see their Team Lead and get their name Tag

6. MODE OF DRESSING

a. Ensure you have all required uniforms, including 1. Red Armless Jacket 2. White Armless Jacket 3. White or Red Round Neck 4. Varsity Jacket 5. Red Polo 6. White Polo 7. White sweat shirt 8. 1 Face Cap.

b. Outfits for each prayer session will be communicated a week before the 72hrs. Correct and announced outfits must be worn, else officiating may not

be allowed or may take place at the back of the Auditorium.

c. Contact the Coordinator before the program if you encounter any uniform-related difficulties.

d. Dress smartly for all programs. Native dresses such as iro and buba, boubou, abaya, slippers and similar styles are no longer permissible.

e. Red and white are the official colors of the Beulah Team. It is mandatory for every member to wear the designated officiating uniform for each program. It is not allowed for any member to wear a different uniform while officiating. If a member cannot wear red for spiritual reasons, he or she should sit among the congregation for that prayer session

f. Please be inform that we do not permit multi-color scarves, slippers, excessive jewelry or bubu dresses, if you do not have the assigned uniform for a particular prayer session, kindly refrain from duty. Except the intending members.

g. Our Official Colour is Red and white, if you are not allow to wear Red, please abstain from duty, when Red is assigned for Officiation.

7.ADVANCE TEAM

a. The Beulah Cleaning Team “**AFOLE FUN KRISTI**” arrive at the campground a week before 72hrs to commence cleaning of Auditorium.

b. Participation in the cleaning exercise is mandatory for all Beulah members present at the campground. If you are unable to join due to a valid reason, it is crucial to contact the Coordinator and explain your circumstances. Remember, Beulah's primary responsibility is cleaning, and we proudly identify as "Afolẹ fun Kristi."

c. Members who are at the campground but refuse to participate in the cleaning activity will face suspension for a designated period.

8. FINANCE

- a. Every member is required to pay a monthly due of N5,000 into fellowship account only
- b. New members are required to pay three months of monthly dues upfront immediately after completing their internship. After that, they will be added to the main platform.
- c. Members who intentionally do not pay the monthly dues, or fail to provide a reasonable reason, will be disengaged when they have six months outstanding.

b. REVENUE DRIVE

- I. A revenue drive will be conducted every three months.
- ii. The revenue drive process begins with the Executive and then extends to other members.
- iii. Members with outstanding payments will be contacted and expected to settle their dues.
- iv. Members continuously owing for three consecutive months without a valid reason will be suspended.
- v. After two suspensions, a member will need to rejoin through the new intending member process before reentry to the main group.
- vi. Suspended members will not participate in any Beulah program until dues are settled.
- c. Monthly financial reports, encompassing both donations and dues, will be shared on the group platform.
- d. Apart from the mandatory monthly dues, some members also voluntarily contribute to support our quarterly 72hrs project. Please note that this project's contribution is not compulsory.

9. TEAM LEAD

The Team Lead oversees member position placement during camp programs. Team Leads can be regular members or executive members. To qualify as a Team Lead, the following criteria must be met:

A. Executive or member Team Leads must be on the campground latest on Thursday for 72hrs preparation. Absence on these days disqualifies one from being a Team Lead.

B. Team Leads must demonstrate impartiality in member placement. Any biased behavior disqualifies a person from serving as a Team Lead.

C. Team Leads must be present 10 minutes before prayer sessions to prevent placement disputes within their teams.

D. Each Team Lead has a designated jurisdiction. Management is limited to this jurisdiction. In the absence of a Team Lead, the Coordinator will stand in or assign a replacement.

E. Team Leads must stay within their jurisdiction. In the absence of a Team Lead, the Coordinator will take charge or provide temporary/permanent replacements.

F. Team Leads cannot invite members from other teams to officiate. If an important position needs filling, the Team Lead must consult other Team Leads for approval.

G. Any Team Lead who invites a member from another team will receive warnings for the first three occurrences, and thereafter, lose their Team Lead position.

H. Members not following Team Lead instructions will receive warnings for the first three instances, and their names will not appear on the roster, leading to non-welcome by all Team Leads.

10. IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

A. Being a Beulah Member does not grant automatic access to Prophet Taiwo Ojo for counseling. The proper process for counseling must be followed.

B. Membership in Beulah does not guarantee room reservation during programs. Reservation procedures will be strictly followed.

C. If a member wishes to report an issue, they should contact at least two of the ADMINS on the WhatsApp group or wait for the general meeting for appropriate discussion.

D. Beulah Team now includes a First Aid Team operating within Beulah. They collaborate with the camp's medical team upon request.

E. "You will be blacklisted from purchasing uniforms if you have three months outstanding dues and a history of significant backlog. You must clear your outstanding balance before being eligible to purchase any uniforms."

E. GROUP PRAYER AND FASTING: Beulah members from all over the world gather on Zoom every Wednesday to pray and fast from 5:00 pm to 6:00 pm via zoom

F. Kindly note that these Rules and Regulations may be updated quarterly. Any updates will be posted on the general platform.

11. MISCONDUCT PENALTY

Beulah is a department within the Christ Apostolic Church Covenant of Mercy. Members are expected to uphold the reputation of Beulah and avoid actions that reflect negatively on the department. The following penalties apply for Beulah Member Misconduct:

i. Fund mismanagement will result in immediate expulsion from the group for both executives and members.

ii. Beulah members must not engage in any form of item distribution without explicit consent from the Coordinator, Executive, or their designated representative present at the prayer meeting. If a member must assist without informing the person in charge, they should not wear the Beulah uniform to avoid any potential implications. Any member who disobeys this guideline will be suspended for three consecutive programs.

iii. At all prayer meetings, Beulah members must wear their name tags. This allows any member who commits wrongdoing to be identified by the name on their tag. Members must not officiate without a name tag; failure to comply will result in suspension for three consecutive programs.

iv. Wearing the correct uniform is mandatory. If you do not have the designated uniform, please refrain from officiating. Any member or executive officiating in incorrect attire will be suspended for three consecutive programs.

v. Members or executives who violate the officiating placement rules will also be suspended for three consecutive programs. Placement can only be assigned by the Coordinator, Assistant Coordinator, or a team lead approved by the executives.

vi. Public arguments or conflicts that tarnish Beulah's image are strictly prohibited. Engaging in such behavior will lead to a one-year suspension during which the member must consistently pay monthly dues without delay.

vii. Biased Team Leads will be relieved of their position.

viii. Members with ideas to benefit Beulah should communicate them through the coordinator or during general meetings. Sharing ideas directly with the Prophet without consulting executives will result in a one-year suspension, during which monthly dues must be promptly paid.

ix. Attendance for advance auditorium cleaning before programs is mandatory for all campground members. Failure to participate without a valid reason will result in a four-month suspension starting from the relevant

72-hours or special program.

x. Members and executives found spreading negative remarks about Beulah to non-members will be expelled.

xi. Camp arrivals coming late and failing to wait at the back as team assignments are made will have their names excluded from the roster until compliance is shown.

xii. Attendance at general meetings is obligatory. Missing two consecutive Zoom meetings without prior apology will lead to a suspension.

These guidelines ensure the integrity and positive reputation of Beulah Team within the Christ Apostolic Church Covenant of Mercy.
